Monitoring the impementation of CRPD

National Human Rights Commission of Korea (2018)

- Selection of 62 Core issues, based on C.O., Lol, domestic issues
- Deveoping indicators based on human righthts indicators
 - Structure(Pledge) and Process(Efforts), Outcome indicator(Output)
 - Data source: Fac-based data and Socio-economic-administrative data, survey, eperts' opinion
- Survey & FGI
- Consultation by experts

Core principle of indicators

- **Data** to be Nationwide and regularly collected data, and disaggregated by sex, age, types of disability, to have a baseline and benchmark
- **Indicators** to be base on the newest disability rights model
- **Link with SDGs**
- **Engagement** Statistics, focal point, coordination mechanism, UN agencies, international cooperation, regional organisations, independent monitoring body, CSOs and DPOs
- **Reference** to Indicators by Office of the High Commissioner of Human Rights, along with Structure and Process indicators
