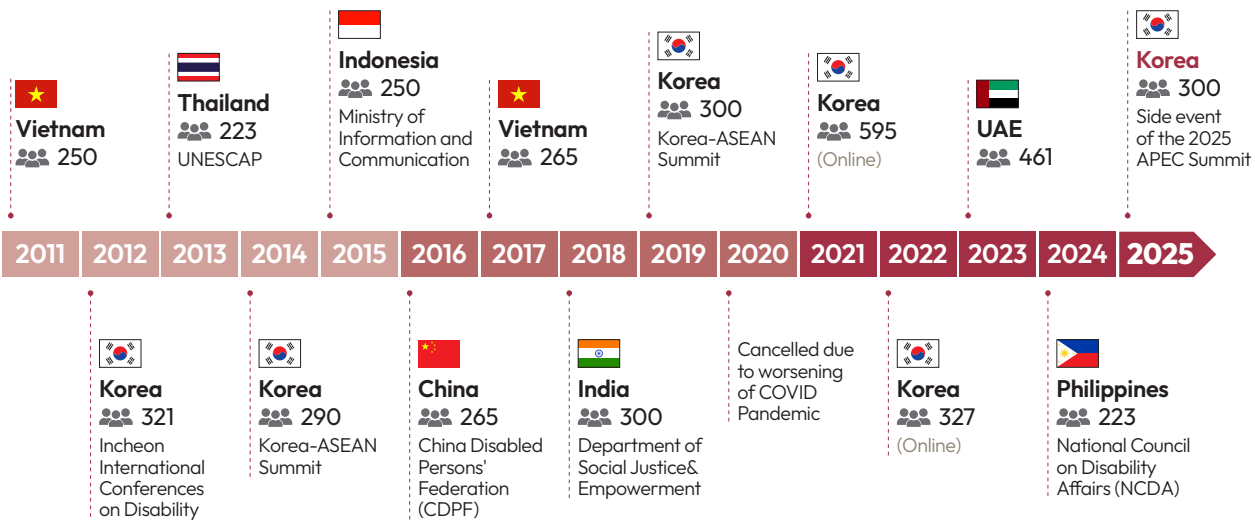


Global IT Challenge

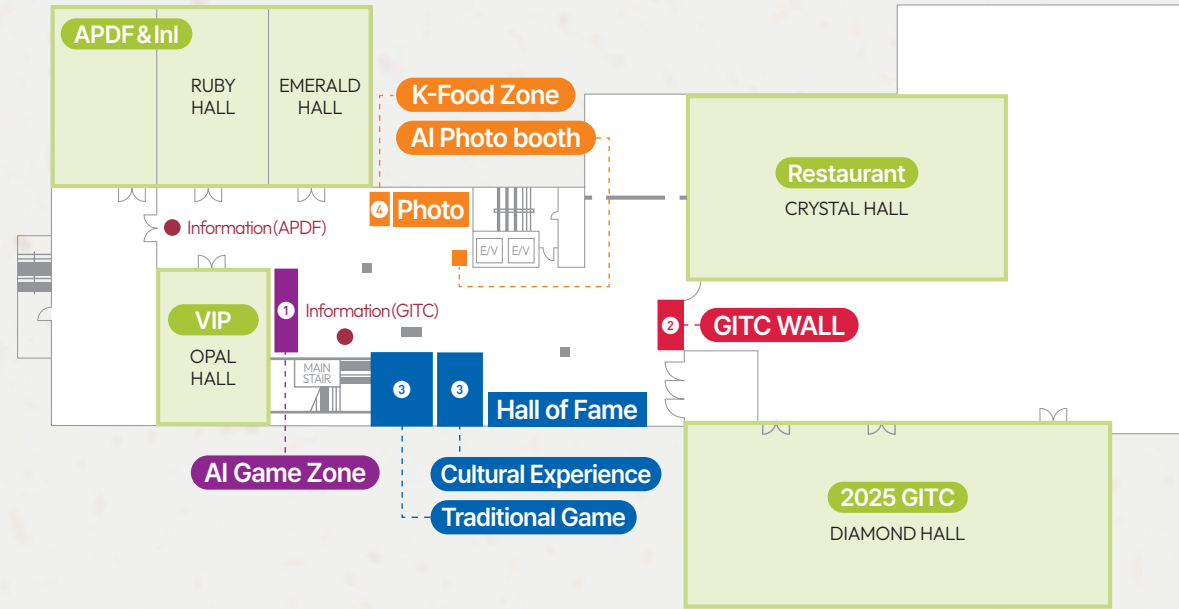
